

## **Campus/Facilities**

### **Asbestos Policy (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act) AHERA**

Under AHERA, the District shall identify asbestos-containing materials and take appropriate actions to control release of Asbestos fibers. The complete policy is located in the Fayetteville ISD Administration Office and is available for public inspection. It is covered under CKA Legal; 40 CFR 763.84; 25 TAC 289.143

### **Cafeteria Services**

- A. The District participates in the National School Lunch Program and offers free and reduced-price meals based on a student's financial need. Information on this program can be obtained from the central office. Fayetteville I.S.D. operates a closed campus during lunch.

Any parent has the right, without prior arrangement and on any school day, to check his/her child out and personally take that student to lunch at a place of the parent's choice and return the student to school in time for the first afternoon class.

Any student who skips out, or violates the lunch policy may be subject for disciplinary action. The violation (leaving the school for lunch without permission) will be treated like that of a student skipping class.

Fayetteville I.S.D. has a well-equipped and professionally staffed cafeteria.

During the lunch period, students may not be in the locker area or parking lot. The following are student areas that students may be during the lunch period: in the cafeteria, in front of the building, in the rest room adjacent to the cafeteria, or in the office. Students are expected to eat in the cafeteria in an orderly fashion.

Occasionally, students may have to wait in line to get their trays. "Cutting" in line is not permitted and offenders may be prohibited from eating cafeteria meals, prohibited from eating in the cafeteria, assigned cafeteria clean up, or corrected in a manner deemed appropriate by the administrators or duty staff.

Soft drink machines will not be available for elementary students during lunch.

### **Library**

The Fayetteville I.S.D. Library is a member of the Texas Library Connection (TLC). The TLC allows students to access other TLC memberships in regards to research and materials. All students entering the F.I.S.D. Library are required to have a hall pass issued by their classroom teacher. Upon entering the library, students are to present their hall pass and library assignment to the Librarian for approval. Students are not permitted to bring any food or drink into the library.

### **Lockers**

Lockers remain under the jurisdiction of the school even when assigned to an individual student. The school reserves the right to inspect all lockers. A student has

full responsibility for the security of the locker and is responsible for making certain it is locked and that the combination is not available to others. Searches of lockers may be conducted at any time there is reasonable cause to do so whether or not the student is present.

### **Lost and Found**

A lost-and-found department will be maintained in the principal's office. Any article found should be turned into the office. During the last week of each semester, items not claimed will be discarded.

### **Lunchroom**

Free/Reduced Applications – The district participates in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Program and offers free and reduced-priced breakfasts and lunches to students based on financial need. Anyone who can qualify for free/reduced should complete the “Free/Reduced Lunch Application” form and return it to school.

Prices – Breakfast [\$1.00 for students, \$1.25 for adults], Lunch [\$1.50 for K-5 students, \$2.00 for 6-12 students, \$2.75 for adults]. Reduced rates can be obtained from the office. No more than two lunch charges will be allowed.

Visitors – Visitors for lunch should call the school prior to 8:30 a.m. to ensure preparation of enough food.

### **Pest Control Information**

The District periodically applies pesticides inside buildings. Information regarding the application of pesticides is available from the Superintendent’s office at (979) 378-4242.

### **Use of Trained Dogs**

In an effort to prevent and detect drug and alcohol abuse problems in the schools and maintain a safe school environment conducive to education, the District will periodically use specially trained dogs to sniff out concealed contraband, drugs, or alcohol on school property. All visits to the school will be unannounced. The dogs will be used to check vacant classrooms, commons areas, student lockers, and automobiles parked on school property. If the dog alerts to a particular locker, car, or item in classrooms or other common areas, these areas may be searched. If the dog alerts to a car, the student will be asked, if necessary, to unlock the car doors and trunk for an internal inspection. If the student refuses, the parents will be notified. The lockers and parking lots and all other school properties are under the jurisdiction of the District. If in the account, a prohibited substance is found, the student will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include but not limited to suspension, expulsion, alternative placement, and/or notification of law enforcement agencies.

### **Vehicles at School**

Only those students who are properly licensed and insured will be permitted to drive motor vehicles to school. All vehicles must be parked upon arrival at the campus, and students are not to sit in parked cars. Students may not go to the vehicle during the school hours (exception: leaving campus or administrative authorization). Careless

and irresponsible driving will not be permitted. Vehicles parked on school property are under the jurisdiction of the school. The school reserves the right to search any vehicle if reasonable cause exists to do so. Students have full responsibility for the security of their vehicles and will make certain they are locked and that the keys are not given to others. Students will be held responsible for any prohibited objects or substances, such as weapons, alcohol and drugs, that are found in their cars and will be subject to disciplinary action.
