

# Transportation

## Buses /School Vehicles

The F.I.S.D. makes school bus transportation available to all students living within the school district. This service is provided at no cost to students. Bus routes and any subsequent changes can be found in the school office. Students are expected to assist District staff in ensuring that buses remain in good condition and that transportation is provided safely.

When riding in school vehicles, students must:

- Follow the driver's directions at all times.
- Enter and leave the vehicle in an orderly manner at the designated stop.
- Keep feet, books, and other object out of the aisle.
- Not deface the vehicle or its equipment.
- Not put head, hands, arms, or legs out of the window, hold any object out of the window, or throw any objects within or outside of the vehicle.
- Not possess, smoke or use any form of tobacco product in the vehicle.  
    Not bring food or drink of any kind in the vehicle. [No gum, candy, or sunflower seeds are allowed
- Upon leaving the bus, wait for driver's signal before crossing in front of vehicle.
- When provided, wear seatbelts at all times (bus or van).

Misconduct will be punished in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct; bus-riding privileges may be suspended. **Note:** Video cameras may be used in District vehicles to promote compliance with the rules of conduct. Videotapes are protected student records.
